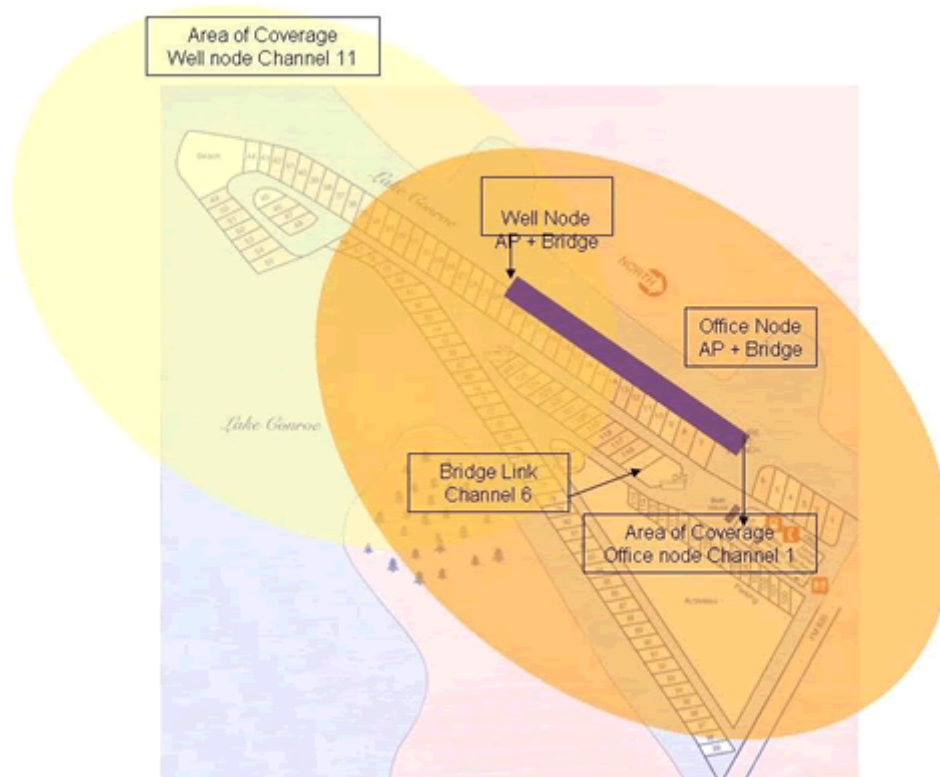

RV Parks Driving into the Wireless Age - Technical Aspects of the Project

BeauDeux uses an airPoint PRO Outdoor with an amplified sector antenna (sB2510) as a remote access point. It is connected to an airPoint PRO Total (sB2520) that is directed towards the office. Another airPoint PRO Total (sB2520) sits on the roof of the office. A Cat-5 cable comes into the office, goes through a lightning arrestor and is connected into the network. On a separate mast on the roof is another amplified sector antenna acting as the access point for that end of the park. This antenna is connected to an airPoint (sB2400) which is connected to the network.



"The whole park is illuminated and whilst I would have preferred not to amplify the signal, there was really no alternative. The amplifier is bi-directional and allows the already very sensitive access point radios to detect and receive a signal from quite a long way in campers' coaches. Those who elect to install separate wireless bridges or USB wireless cards with antennas get superb reception," explains Mr. Beauchemin.
